Oh, so close. Again.

For the second time in three years, the **Summerville** High **wrestling** team came up a tad short in a bid to win its first state championship since 2008.

The Green Wave fell just shy of the Class AAAAA championship on Saturday night, losing to Upper State champion Fort Mill, 34-32, at Dreher High School in Columbia. Summerville lost to Hillcrest, 36-33, in the finals two seasons ago.

Summerville finishes this season with a 28-3 record overall.

The championship started in the 160-pound weight class and **Summerville**'s Steele Walker gave the Green Wave a 3-0 lead with a 5-0 win.

Fort Mill recorded a pin at 170 and earned a four-point victory at 182 to take a 10-3 lead in the team scoring.

Summerville's Mason Ayers provided a pin at 195, making it 10-9 in the team scoring, but**Fort Mill** picked up a pin at 220 and a 1-0 win at 285 to move ahead, 19-9.

A huge match at 106 was won by a **Fort Mill** pin and the Yellow Jackets led, 25-9. The Green Wave's Xavier Anderson won, 12-0, at 113, and Caleb Herring won, 10-6, at 120 to bring **Summerville** closer at 25-16.

Fort Mill picked up a pin at 126 to move ahead, 31-16, but **Summerville** answered with pins by Ben Guilliam (132) and Hunter Hickman (138) to make it 31-28 with two matches left.

Fort Mill earned three points with a win at 145, setting up the final contest of the evening at 152 pounds.

Summerville's Hassan Williams needed a pin to tie the team score, but could manage only a technical fall for four team points. A pin would have been **Summerville**'s fourth, which would have given the Green Wave the championship on criteria points.
